Unionized faculty and staff across the Commonwealth at community colleges, state universities and UMass campuses have been attempting for months to negotiate successor contracts. At the bargaining table, we have all been offered the same: **NOTHING!**

We are told that the state budget for public higher education is "flat-funded." This situation contributes to course cancellations and layoffs, inadequate staffing levels, the continued lack of wage parity, job security and benefits for adjunct and part-time faculty members, and more hikes in tuition and fees for students. Meanwhile, the state's per-student investment in public education has declined 31% since 2001.

Public education and our unions are under attack, but MTA higher education members working together can fight for our issues, rights and values.
